African Vision of Hope Update - Chapel offerings Aug-October

"In the midst of the worst drought in Zambia in over 30 years, African Vision of Hope has fed over 23,000 people daily. In the past month, 240 families were provided with cornmeal and vegetable oil, essential to making Zambia's staple food "nshima", as a part of African Vision of Hope's emergency feeding program. Many shared, that it had been days since they or their children had eaten. One woman shared, "Even the flies had left my house for a lack of food." Now the community is dancing with joy, as they head home to prepare meals for their family, **and it is all thanks to faithfulness like yours.**"

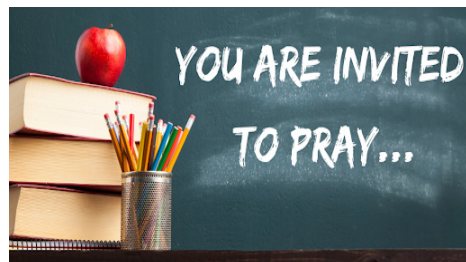
Charger Bucks/Scrip - Start using today!
