
You can start shopping today for unique Chargerwear! The store will be open through Sunday, November 10th at midnight. Orders should arrive before Thanksgiving.

Continue the Conversation

- 1. Questions are a way to know and be known.
- 2. Jesus knows us without having to ask any questions.
- 3. To search is to look for and find.

EVERYONE IS A STORYTELLER /// Just as we are teaching the students to share their stories, we want you as parents to share yours as well! During dinner or in the car ask about your child's day and then share your own! Encourage your students to take turns asking questions. Doing this will create a deeper connection for your family and put what they are learning in school into their home environment!

GOD'S LOVE IS UNCONDITIONAL /// Because God wrote our stories, He knows every single bump, mistake, failure, and loss along the way. Regardless of knowing all of our weak moments, God loves us anyway. There is nothing we need to prove to Him or level of perfection we need to reach.
