#### Pastor's Corner - Pastor Packer

This is a beautiful summary of the themes of this Sunday's readings: The Sower sows the seed of His Word (Luke 8:4–15). This Word is living and powerful (Heb. 4:9–13) to conceive new life in those who hear it. But the planting of Christ is attacked by the devil, the world, and the flesh. Satan snatches the Word FROM DUR **PASTOR** away from hard hearts. The riches and pleasures of this life choke off faith. Shallow and emotional belief withers in time of temptation and trouble. But see how Christ bears this attack for us! Christ's cross was planted in the hard and rocky soil of Golgotha. A crown of thorns was placed upon His head. Satan and His demons hellishly hounded and devoured Him. Yet, through His dying and rising again, He destroyed these enemies of ours. Jesus is Himself the Seed which fell to the ground and died in order that it might sprout forth to new life and produce much grain. In Him, the weak are strong (2 Cor. 11:19–12:9). He is the Word of the Father which does not return void (Is. 55:10–13) but vields a harvest hundredfold.

#### **Chapel Service**


On March 5, we will observe Ash Wednesday with a special chapel service, which will include the imposition of ashes. During this service, your student will have the opportunity to receive a cross made of ashes on their forehead or the back of their hand. This sign symbolizes both our sin and mortality, as well as the hope we have through Jesus' death on the cross and His resurrection.

This will be the first time Good Shepherd incorporates this tradition during chapel. If you have any questions, please feel free to reach out to your child's teacher for more information. You are invited to join us for chapel that morning.

**Step 2:** Submit payment for application (\$40)

Step 3: Submit ALL 2024 tax documents by April 10

- Applicant & co-applicant must submit tax docs
- Taxes do not have to be filed, but must be prepared and uploaded to application

#### **Step 4: CHECK EMAIL**

- FACTS representatives will email if documentation is missing. Please respond as soon as possible and check your junk folder for FACTS emails.

#### **Required Documentation**

- 2024—1040 Tax Form (page 1 & 2)
- 2024 W2
- Business Income docs
  - $\Rightarrow$  Schedule 1—5, C, E, K, etc.
- Non-taxable docs
  - ⇒ Child support, SNAP, TANF, Social Security

#### **Do You Qualify?**

- If at least 10% of income from 2024 is used to cover the cost of a child/ children's Lutheran K-8 net tuition
- Child/children must be enrolled at the school by April 30 to be eligible for a scholarship during the May awards

#### Good Shepherd Lutheran School's Scrip Program

What is Scrip?

Scrip is a tuition reduction program for school families and friends.

You simply order gift cards to pay for things you would normally be purchasing. Good Shepherd families share an extra benefit by participating in the program because they earn credits which reduce the cost of their tuition payment based on their individual spending. Participating families will receive credits posted to their family tuition account in February and August. The credits are split 50/50 for reduction of your tuition and the school's general fund.

Orders may be placed by turning in a weekly order (green) sheet with a check or exact cash. Please have your child turn the order in to the school office or give it to their teacher. These orders will be filled on weeks when school is in session a full five days. They will be given to your child's teacher on Friday to be sent home.
