We all have anxiety. Anxiety is felt at every age and every walk of life. I have noticed an increase in anxiety among children and teens with the demands of school, sports, friendships, and family life. You may notice anxiety in your child and wonder if it's "normal". Sometimes anxiety is good- it helps us study for a test, perform a major task, or keep focused while driving through a snow storm. Parents can help their child identify what is making them anxious, how to deal with it, and develop coping skills. If you notice your child cannot cope well or has more anxiety than what is expected, I can help!

Teacher Openings:





Do You Qualify?

- If at least 10% of income from 2024 is used to cover the cost of a child/ children's Lutheran K-8 net tuition
- Child/children must be enrolled at the school by April 30 to be eligible for a scholarship during the May awards
